NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the draft of the following rules further to amend the Karnataka Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989, was published as required by section 138 read with section 212 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), in notification No. HFD 90 TMA 99 dated 12th October 2000, published in part VI, 20th (i) of the Karnataka Gazette Extraordinary dated 19th October, 2000 inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby within expiry of thirty days from the date of its publication of the draft in the Official Gazette.

And whereas, the said Gazette was made available to public on 19.10.2000.

And Whereas, no objections and suggestions have been received by the Government.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 138, read with section 212 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

RULES

1. Title and Commencement - (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Rules, 2001.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Insertion of new rule 230A - (1) In the Karnataka Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, after rule 230, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:-

"230A Prohibition of using or holding mobile phone while driving :-
(1) No person shall while driving any motor vehicle in a public place, use or hold in his hand a mobile phone.

(2) If no person other than the driver is sitting in or on the motor vehicle, the mobile phone, if any, shall be switched off, during the journey.

In this modern world communication and communication skills have assumed lot of importance. One needs to be in constant touch with his/her surrounding to be a successful socializing person. The cell phones with different applications have conquered the world with all the benefits that they can give to the user. It's nearly impossible to imagine a day without the use of cell phones. We use cell phones for conveying facts, ideas, concepts, opinions, beliefs, attitudes, instructions and even emotions.

BUT WHEN IT COMES TO USE OF CELL PHONES WHILE DRIVING AND OR RIDING IT IS VERY, VERY DANGEROUS The traffic on road is a dynamic entity. The road conditions are not something like laboratory conditions, where all other factors remain constant and only certain things tend to vary. Every second your brain need to work and take and make many decisions. The use of cell phone is very dangerous when you are on



wheels. There are varieties of driver distraction reasons, but the use of cell phones while driving is of primary concern. The extent of this problem remains unknown, as data on mobile phone use is not routinely collected when there is a road crash due to this factor alone. But we now know how disastrous it would be to harm others due to our bad manners of using cell phone while driving/riding.

Effects of mobile phone use on driving behaviour:

Every person using a cell phone and driving a vehicle feels that he is an expert in driving skills. But in reality.....?

- Using mobile phones can cause drivers to take their concentration and eyes off the road, their hands off the steering and their minds off the road and pay least attention to surrounding situation.
- Evidences show that the distraction caused by mobile phones can impair person's driving performance in a number of ways, e.g. longer reaction.
- Impaired ability to keep in the correct lane, and the person fails to judge his exact location on the road.
- Text messaging also results in considerably reduced driving performance.
- They disturb vehicular movement by either driving slowly or in the middle of the road. At junctions, traffic police regularly notice motorists who do not move even after the light turns green because they are speaking over the phone or texting.
- Studies conducted elsewhere in foreign countries suggest that drivers using a mobile phone are approximately four times more likely to be involved in a crash than when a driver does not use a phone.
- Though there is no conclusive evidence to show that hands-free phones are any safer than hand-held phones, because of the distraction involved with both types of phones is almost similar.

Even when cell-phone drivers direct their gaze at objects in the driving environment, they often fail to "see" them because attention has been diverted to the cell-phone conversation.



Two types of cell phone behavior typically lead to unsafe driving conditions:

- Handling the phone: dialing, answering, text messaging, etc.
- The conversation introduced to the environment. Thought fumbling with the cell phone itself was a more dangerous activity than your conversation? Think again. That conversation involves quite large chunk of your thought, which according to study simulations sucks the life out of your driving concentration, especially your ability to react when seconds count.

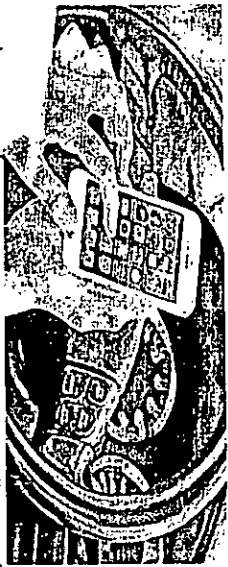
The negative effects of mobile phone use are not only due to physical, visual and auditory distraction stemming from operating the phone and the vehicle at the same time, but also because drivers have to divide their attention between using the phone and driving (cognitive distraction). As also cognitive. The fact that many drivers own and use a mobile phone has raised concerns among scientists, the media, and policymakers. The early mobile phones had only a call function, but the modern smartphones have more and more functions, e.g. text messaging, e-mail, internet use, that may distract the driver. This fact sheet describes the reasons why it is hazardous to use a phone in the car, discusses the effect on the crash risk, and discusses the possible measures and the effectiveness of legal prohibition

Mobile phone use can distract drivers in various ways:

1. visually, such as by looking at a screen instead of at the road;
2. auditory distraction, when focusing on sounds like, for instance, a ringtone, so that fewer environmental sounds can reach the road user;
3. bio-mechanically/physically, such as when a mobile phone is operated manually;
4. cognitively, when the driver is thinking about something (about the conversation he/she is conducting, for instance) not related to the driving task.

What the law says?

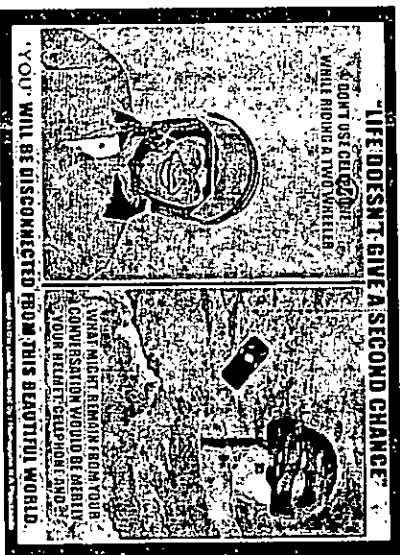
The law of the land has banned use of cell phone while driving. Section 177 of the Indian Motor Vehicles Act and Section 230A of the Karnataka Motor Vehicles Rules (holding/using mobile phone while riding/driving a vehicle) as an offence. *No person shall while driving any motor vehicle in a public place, use or hold in his hand a mobile phone. Further the rule says if no person other than the driver is sitting in or on the motor vehicle the mobile phone if any, shall be switched off during the journey.*



The Police have powers to recommend cancellation of licenses even if it is a first-time offence. "Section 19 (f) of Indian Motor Vehicle Act and Rule 21 (25) of Central Motor Vehicle Rules empowers Police to recommend cancellation of licence even if it a first-time offence," by the driver.

The traffic police not only book the cell phone users just for using cell phone while driving but also add dangerous driving/reckless driving.

Increasing public awareness Campaigns to increase public understanding of driving while distracted are also need to increase awareness among the public that for drivers, hands-free phones appear to be as distracting as hand-held phones. Many companies now address distracted driving within fleet safety policies, limiting or prohibiting the use of mobile phones while driving. Mobile phones have become increasingly integrated into all aspects of day to day life. Mobile phones have immense public utility, improving communication in social and commercial interactions. Nonetheless, their role in driver distraction and consequently in road traffic crashes means that some measure of preventing and deterring their use while driving is very much required. This will require harsh or stringent legislative measures, creative ways of enforcement, some degree of regulation of industry,



and a shift in societal perceptions about what behaviour is "acceptable" when driving. Failure to act now could not only make it more difficult to address the issue at a later date, but would also lead to many more preventable traffic fatalities on the roads of this city. Please don't use cell phone somebody is waiting for you at home. Please don't forget you are the purpose of their life.
