BJP bags Palike; Goutham Kumar mayor, Raju deputy

BENGALURU, DHNS

he BJP on Tuesday won the mayor and deputy mayor posts at the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike amid some drama. Making a clean sweep, the party wrested power from the Cong: ess-JD(S) coalition which held the reins for four consecutive years.

M Goutham Kumar, two-time BJP corporator from Jogupalya Ward (No. 89), was elected as the 53rd mayor of Bengaluru while C.R. Rammohan Raju, a BJP corporator from Bommanahalli, was chosen his deputy.

Emerging as a dark horse in a tough fight between two top contenders of BJP, Goutham sprung

a surprise with his selection as BJP's mayoral candidate. Goutham defeated Congress candidate R S Sathyanarayana by a simple majority and became the first mayor of

Bengaluru with North-Indian roots.

A commerce graduate, Goutham belongs to the minority Jain community. Goutham's family moved from Hajivas in Beawar district of Rajasthan and settled down in Siruguppa in Ballari 1946. They later shifted to Bengaluru. The family runs the Vijay Kumar Kawarlal Jain Junior College in Siruguppa.

Goutham is the youngest of five brothers and two sisters and his wife Rekha is a home-maker. His daughter studies in Class 12 while the son is in Class 5.

Goutham faced anxious moments when 'rebel' candidate Padmanabha Reddy filed his nomination. He heaved a sigh of relief when Reddy backed out minutes before the voting in a dramatic turn of events.

A loyal BJP worker, Goutham has been associated with the RSS since a young age. Climbing the political ladder, Goutham worked at various levels of BJP's youth wing and the Bengaluru unit of the BJP. In fact, he was an aspirant for a ticket from Shantinagar during the last Assembly elections.

Sharing his plans for the city soon after being elected as mayor. Gontham said he would focus on ensuring a complete ban on plastic and decongesting the city's roads.

Raju, the new deputy mayor, is a corporator from Bommanahalli and a native of Bengaluru. A diploma holder in civil engineering, Raju has been an active worker in various ranks of BJP for several years.
