Ktaka to shift to paperless

Bengaluru: With a sudden spike in Covid-19 cases, the government has decided to fortify its internal communication and go paperless.

In two orders issued by chief minister BS Yediyurappa and chief secre-tary TM Vijay Bhaskar, the government said all files and communication will henceforth be via its internal software, e-office.

"With the state seeing increasing number of Covid-19 cases, all communications and files to my office will not be accepted via hard copy. Files will only be accepted in virtual format via e-office from June 1," the CM said in his letter to all departments.

The CS said all files for cabinet consideration must be sent via e-office.

Having launched the portal in November 2019, eoffice was supposed to make the government go paperless but was not implement ed in letter and spirit
