Bengaluru: In a sudden change of district in-charge ministers, chief minister BS Yediyurappa on Tuesday issued orders naming food and civil supplies minister K Gopalaiah as Hassan district in-charge minister and water resources minister Ramesh Jarkiholi as Belagavi district in-charge.

The decision appears to be a political one as local legislators in the two districts have been crying foul over law minister JC Madhuswamy and deputy chief minister

PAC drops motion against speaker

The Public Accounts Committee headed by Congress MLA HK Patil dropped its proposal to move a privilege motion against speaker Vishweshwar Hegde Kageri owing to opposition by ruling BJP members. Kageri had allegedly denied permission to PAC members to visit quarantine centres and Covid-19 hospitals to check the quality of PPE kits, sanitisers and other medical equipment. But BJP members KG Bopaiah, AS Patil Nadahalli, Ravi Subramanya and others reportedly took Patil to task for not consulting other members before deciding to move the motion. **TNN**
