Bengaluru: Hours after Congress accused the government of cutting off rice and wheat supplies to Sri Siddaganga mutt, an influential Lingayat mutt in Tumakuru, for its Anna Dasoha (free food) scheme, the state cabinet, which met on Tuesday, decided to restore supplies by allocating Rs 18 crore.
