No more villages will be added to BBMP limits

But the number of wards will increase

The joint select committee, which met on Friday to discuss 40 issues, is not considering adding 65 villages to the BBMP limits. However, increasing the number of wards from 198 to 225 is on the cards.

BJP MLA S. Raghu, who was part of the meeting, clarified that the BBMP limits would not be increased further and there was no proposal either before the abutting the city.

However, on Thursday, following a Cabinet meeting, Minister for Law and Parliamentary Affairs J.C. Madhuswamy had hinted otherwise. Sources in the ruling BJP had also said there was a proposal to bring in 65 villages, especially those in the Electronics Bity-Surjapura stretch, the had alread, heen urbanised.
