Manoj Sinha appointed J&K Lt Governor

Former Union Minister Manoj Sinha was on Thursday appointed as the Lieutenant Governor of Jammu and Kashmir, replacing incumbent G C Murmu.

Sources said 61-year-old Sinha will be administered oath by J&K Chief Justice Gita Mittal at Raj Bhavan.

Sinha was junior minister for Railways and Union Minister for Communications in

the first Modi government. Murmu's resignation came on the first anniversary of government's decision to revoke the special status for Jammu and Kashmir. Hewas appointed as CAG as the incumbent Rajiv Mehrishi retires this week.

Sources said Murmu's inability to fill in the "political vacuum" created after the formation of the UT and his stand on restoration of 4G internet led to his resignation. The EC had also objected to his repeated remarks about poll the schedule.

He will succeed Raiiv Mehrishi, whose term will end on Friday as he will be completing 65 years.
