# B'uru shops selling essentials open till noon; no cabs, buses

## Liquor Outlets To Shut; No Curbs On E-Comm Delivery

**Bengaluru:** All essential shops in Bengaluru Urban and Rural districts, except pharmacies, will shut at 12 noon for the next seven days starting Wednesday as part of the Karnataka government's lockdown plan to contain the spread of the coronavirus.

Chief minister BS Yediyurappa ruled out extension of the week-long lockdown in Bengaluru Urban and Rural districts and sought cooperation of the people.

The government on Monday issued guidelines for a fresh round of lockdown, which will be in force from **8pm Tuesday to 5am on July 22**. All grocery shops, milk parlours, vegetable and fruit shops, fish and mutton stalls

will function between **5am and 12 noon** during the lockdown. Shopping malls, commercial establishments, cinema halls, multiplexes, community and marriage halls will remain shut.

The guidelines were issued after consultations by the chief minister with cabinet colleagues and members of the Covid-19 task force. All liquor outlets will remain closed during the lockdown. However, e-commerce companies can deliver products without restrictions.

Public and private bus service, Metro train, cabs and autorickshaws, trains and flights have been banned except in emergencies. However, the trains and flights, which are already scheduled, will be allowed to operate. People scheduled to arrive from or to travel on these trains and flights can book cabs and autos, and their journey ticket will be considered as pass.

Inter-state and intra-state movement of passenger vehicles is allowed only in emergency cases and upon registration or obtaining valid passes through the Seva Sindhu portal. The movement of vehicles within Bengaluru area is allowed only in emergencies or for activities allowed in the guidelines.

## Total lockdown in Dharwad and Dakshina Kannada

**D**harwad and Dakshina Kannada districts have decided to go for complete lockdown while Raichur, Shivamogga and Kalaburagi have opted for a partial one. While DK will be under lockdown for a week from July 16, Dharwad will be for 10 days — from 10am on July 15 to 8pm on July 24. Kalaburagi, Shivamogga and Raichur districts have decided to go for partial lockdown.

The district administrations took a decision after Yediyurappa's video conference with deputy commissioners and superintendents of police of 19 districts.

Mysuru and a few other districts which are seeing a spike in positive cases have decided to impose lockdown in selected areas. In Kodagu, the district administration has imposed curfew from 6pm to 6am from July 15 to 31.

**A**ll government offices — barring police, health and departments dealing with essential services — will remain shut.

Secretariats at Vidhana Soudha, Vikasa Soudha and MS Buildings will function with 50% staff. Vegetable and fruit markets and mandis will function as usual. Also allowed are industrial units, including food-processing industries, manufacturing essential goods, packing material, Special Economic Zones or outside municipal limits and export-oriented units, continuation of works in construction projects, where workers are available on site.
