Call on plasma therapy for Covid-19 left to task force, JMG

New Delhi: The National Task Force on Covid-19 and joint monitoring group (JMG) of the health ministry will decide whether the plasma therapy should be continued in the treatment of coronavirus infected patients in India, said Dr Balram Bhargava, DG of Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), on Tuesday.

Dr Bhargava informed in context with the ICMR findings that revealed convalescent plasma (CP) therapy didn't help in reducing death due to the coronavirus in India. "Plasma therapy has been used for more than 100 years nowfor various virus in-Sections. It was used in ebola and now for Colid-19. Whether it helps in porphavirus meatment or not, it is being stricted It is till and anyong peer review, he said during a press conference Lere.

"Once peer review happens and we get a full publication out, this data will be considered again by the NTF and joint monitoring group of health ministry, then a decision will be taken if we should continue with it," he said. ANI
