Accused of graft, speaker hits out

Bengaluru: Speaker KR Ramesh Kumar on Friday almost burst into tears after accusations surfaced that he was asking members to accept resignations. When the House assembled, Kumar made a mention of the issue and turned emotional.

"While you people (parties) fight for power, I am sitting on fire," he said. "Allegations are being levelled against me and I am being made the culprit for supposedly delaying the trust vote." Kumar said even his family members were making jokes about him on Friday morning.

"Today, when I was leaving home, my

daughter-in-law joked, 'Appa, we are richer by Rs 12 crore today', insinuating that I am using money to delay my decision on resignations," Kumar said.

Later, while the debate on the trust vote began and allegations of horse-trading flew thick and fast, Kumar intervened, saying: "You people (political parties, media and bureaucrats) do not want legislators with integrity. Today, I am intentionally allowing all names and allegations of horse-trading to be entered into the record so future generations will know what happened on this day." TNN
