A day after the Shiv Sena-NCP-Congress coalition government in Maharashtra resolved to make reading of the Preamble to the Constitution compulsory in schools, the Congress government in adjoining Madhya Pradesh has followed suit.

The School Education Department decided on Wednesday to make reading out of the Preamble compulsory for students in all government schools in the state every Saturday.

In every primary school and middle school, the students, during the Assembly, will read out the Preamble under the guidance of the head master/teacher. In High School and Higher Secondary School, the students will recite the Preamble under guidance of the school's principal during the Bal Sabha, which is held every Saturday.

Welcoming the move, the opposition BJP said that the government should also be ready to face questions from school students pertaining to the Constitution.
