session extended

NEW DELHI, 25th July: Just a day before the session to end, the government on Thursday informed the Lok Sabha that Parliament sittings will be extended till August 7 with an intention to pass more bills.

With this, Parliament will be sitting for 38 days, in probably one of the highest number of sittings in the first session of any L.S. The decision to extend the session was made by Parliamentary Affairs Minister Pralhad Joshi in the Lok Sabha, soon after the House passed the triple talaq bill was passed.

The government wants the extension because over a dozen bills are pending in the either of the House. On Thursday, three new bills were introduced.
