

THE contours of government formation in Maharashtra became clearer by late Wednesday night although leaders of the Shiv Sena, NCP and the Congress remained tightlipped about exact allocation of ministerial berths.

Senior NCP leader and former Union minister Praful Patel said there will be only one deputy chief minister who will be from the Sharad Pawar-led party. The Congress will get the Speaker's post, he added.

"At least one or two leaders from all the three parties will take oath as minister along with Uddhay Thackeray tomorrow (Thursday)," Patel told reporters as he emerged from a four-hour-long meeting of Maharashtra Vikas Aghadi leaders at the YB Chavan centre in South Mumbai late on Wednesday night.

While Patel said the deputy CM's name was yet to be decided, sources told TNIE Javant

Patil and Ajit Pawar are the top two contenders for the post.

Congress leader Prithvirai Chauhan is tipped to be the Speaker, according to sources.

Apart from Uddhay Thackeray and Sharad Pawar, Congress leaders Ahmed Patel, K.C. Venugopal and Mallikariun Kharge took part in the deliberations for power sharing.

According to sources, multiple claims for the Speaker's post dragged the talks. Pressure from NCP workers to make Ajit Pawar deputy Chief Minister also stalled discussions, they added.

"December 3 is the deadline for trust vote. Before that, all talks regarding power sharing will be concluded," Patel said. declining to confirm the number of portfolios each alliance partner will get.

Sources told TNIE that Sena

is likely to get 16 ministers including the CM, while the NCP will have 14 ministers including deputy CM. The Congress will have 13 ministerial berths along with the Speaker's post, sources privy to the discussions told this paper.

Patel said the media will be informed about the exact details of who will take oath on Thursday morning.

rashtra Assembly, the number of ministers cannot exceed 4.1. There is, however, no set for mula for the number of serior and junior numisters.

State Congress chief Batasa heb Thorat had earlier said everything would be finalised in a couple of days.

"The ratio of portfolio-shar ing will be finalised in the new i two days. The number of Cara net and Minister of State (Nees) posts to be given to each page will also be finalised in next two days," he said after taking oath as MLA. According to him, the allocation of portfoli os could take time.
