TN governor
signs 7.5%
NEET quota Bill**

CHENNAI, DHNS: After sitting on it for 45 days, Tamil Nadu Governor Banwarilal Purohit has signed into Act the Bill providing 7.5% horizontal reservation in admissions to medical and dental colleges for government school students who clear NEET.

The Governor's assent came a day after Tamil Nadu government used its powers to issue executive directions to provide 7.5% reservation for government school students.

"This is to inform the people of Tamil Nadu that Hon'ble Governor has given his assent to the Bill titled Tamil Nadu Admission to Undergraduate Courses in Medicine, Dentistry, Indian Medicine and Homeopathy on preferential basis to the students of Government Schools Bill 2020," the Raj Bhavan said in a press release.

It added that Purohit had sought legal opinion of Solicitor General of India, Tushar Mehta, through a letter September 26 and the opinion was received on Thursday.
