## Karnataka sees 299 new cases as India count rises sharply

NEW DELHI/BENGALURU, DHNS: India's Covid-19 count registered the highest single-day spike of 8,380 on Sunday, a day which also saw Karnataka registering a record 299 fresh virus cases.

Across the country, the total confirmed cases touched 1,82,143 while the death toll crossed the 5,000-mark.

In Karnataka, an overwhelming majority of cases — 252 (84.25%) — are people who returned from Maharashtra. Bengaluru reported 21 cases.

According to the Health Ministry, 4,614 people recovered on Sunday as against the 11,264 reported on Saturday, indicating that the sharp spike was more on account of Ma-

harashtra updating data from pending records.

As on Sunday, India had 89,995 active cases, while 86,984 had recovered and discharged from hospitals, taking the recovery rate to 47.75%.

The death toll also spiked by 193 taking the total to 5,164 across the country.

Maharashtra, the worst-hit state in the country, accounts for the highest number of fatalities at 2,197, followed by Gujarat (1,007) and Delhi (416).

According to a separate DH Covid-19 Tracker, the total number of confirmed cases was 1,90,558 and the death toll had touched 5,400 at 10 pm on Sunday.
