head RS ethics

New Delhi: Rajya Sabha's Ethics Committee will be headed by BJP MP Prabhat Jha with Chairman of the Upper House M Venkaiah Naidu reconstituting eight House panels on Thursday. Jha replaces his party colleague Narayan Lal Panchariya. The Ethics Committee looks into conduct-related complaints against RS members. Prasanna Acharya of BJD was named chairman of the Committee on Petitions, replacing Jha.

Congress member T Subbarami Reddy was named chairman of the Committee on Subordinate Legislation, A Navaneetha Krishnan of AIADMK will be chairman of the Committee on Government Assurances and BJP member Om Prakash Mathur has been named chairman of the House committee that allots accommodation to members. As per rules of the House, the Rajya Sabha chairman heads the Business Advisory Committee (BAC) and the Committee on Rules. By convention, the deputy chairman heads the Committee on Privileges.

The new members of the BAC are B K Hariprasad of Congress, Narayan Lal Panchariya and Vinay Sahasrabudde of BJP and K Keshava Rao of TRS. New members of the Committee on Rules include Satyanarayan Jatiya (BJP), Swapan Dasgupta and Y S Chowdhary of BJP, P L Punia of Congress, Naresh Gujral of Shiromani Akali Dal and Independent members Subhash Chandra and Amar Singh.
