K'taka to shift to paperless e-office

Bengaluru: With a sudden spike in Covid-19 cases, the government has decided to fortify its internal communication and go paperless.

In two orders issued by chief minister BS Yediyurappa and chief secretary TM Vijay Bhaskar, the government said all files and communication will henceforth be via its internal software, e-office.

"With the state seeing increasing number of Covid-19 cases, all communications and files to my office will not be accepted via hard copy. Files will only be accepted in virtual format via e-office from June 1," the CM said in his letter to all departments.

The CS said all files for cabinet consideration must be sent via e-office.

Having launched the portal in November 2019, e-office was supposed to make the government go paperless but was not implemented in letter and spirit.
