Upset that many Rajya Sabha members were absent despite their names being listed for starred questions, Chairman M Venkaiah Naidu on Monday urged media to publish the names of such MPs.

In a rare instance, the Upper House during 'Question Hour' was adjourned for lunch five minutes before schedule at 12.55 pm. This was due to absence of seven members—all from Opposition parties—whose starred questions were listed.

Those absentees were Dharmapuri Srinivas (TRS), Ravi Prakash Verma (SP), Ronald Sapa Tlau (Congress), MD Nadimul Haq (TMC), Dr Sasikala (AIADMK), Binoy Viswam (CPI) and Pradip Bhattacharya (Congress).

After having asked the question, members were absent. It is a sorry state of affairs, Naidu observed.

"I hope the media will publish the names of those absent, those who are not coming to House in spite of putting the questions, which is a serious matter," he said.
