BENGALURU, DHNS: Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa, who was recently hospitalised after testing positive for Covid-19, is asymptomatic and is clinically stable.

The hospital said that the vital parameters of the chief minister were normal. "He is comfortable and attending to his activities from his room. He continues to be closely monitored by expert specialists," it said.

Opposition leader Siddaramaiah, who is also undergoing treatment for Covid-19, is also doing fine. While he was admitted with a fever, "presently he has no fever and his vital parameters are stable," a statement by Manipal Hospital said.
