Govt tables  
bill to amend  
vehicles act

NEW DELHI, DHNS: The Government on Monday introduced a bill in Lok Sabha to bring in provisions for imposing higher penalties for violations of the Motor Vehicles Act and protection of good samaritans.

The Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Bill, 2019, introduced by Minister of State for Road Transport V K Singh in the Lok Sabha, seeks to bring in provisions for compensation of Rs 5 lakh for death and Rs 2.5 lakh for grievous injury in a motor vehicle accident.

The motor vehicle owner or the insurer would pay the compensation to the legal heirs or the victim. The bill also seeks to simplify rules for registration of new motor vehicles by leaving it on the dealers to make an application for it.

The ministry brought the bill for consideration and passage in the Lok Sabha as it could not get the nod of the Rajya Sabha during the previous Modi government.
