Stop airing party  
issues publicly:  
Nadda to Yatnal

JP national president JP Nadda on Monday asked party leader Basanagouda Patil Yatnal to refrain from publicly airing issues related to the party.

Expressing his displeasure at Yatnal's statements for the past few months against Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa, Nadda asked the Lingayat leader to appear before the party disciplinary committee.

The committee comprises two members — Satyadev Singh, BJP MP from Balrampur, Uttar Pradesh, and Bijoya Chakravarty, Lok Sabha MP from Guwahati.

Yatnal, who came to Delhi on Monday after being summoned, is likely to meet

other leaders, including Nadda, on Tuesday.

Top leaders are of the view that Yatnal was given enough room to raise issues related to the BJP's affairs in Karnataka in the party forum.

"When the party is seized of the matters flagged by him, he should not have continued to attack the CM publicly," said a leader.

By attacking the CM, Yatnal has damaged both the government and party reputation, said the leader.

The party had already served notice on Yatnal and sought an explanation about his open criticism of Yediyurappa and his family members. However, party leaders were upset when Yatnal continued his attack against the CM.
