Lok Sabha MP Delkar found dead in hotel

DADRA Nagar Haveli Lok Sabha MP Mohan Delkar was found dead in south Mumbai's Hotel Sea Green on Monday. He was 58 years old.

Police recovered a suicide note written in Gujarati from independent Lok Sabha MP Delkar's room. "A suicide note has been found. Investigation is being done. The exact cause of death will be known after post-mortem," Mumbai Police said. An accidental death report is being registered based on preliminary information. A detailed probe is on.

Delkar was a seven-time MP from the Dadra Nagar Haveli Lok Sabha constituency in the Union Territory of Dadra Nagar Haveli and Daman Diu.

Delkar's suicide note is written over several pages and contains names of about 40 people. The police are reportedly cross verifying the names mentioned in the suicide note. As per the note, Delkar was not happy with the administration of his constituency. The note also mentioned that no one was listening to him.

Delkar quit Congress in 2019 and won the Lok Sabha election as an independent candidate. He is survived by his wife, a son and a daughter. Other than Congress, he had also won as a BJP candidate in 1998.

An advocate for tribal rights, Delkar was also a member of the Standing Committees on Personnel, Public Grievances, Law and Justice and a member of the Consultative Committee, Ministry of Home Affairs, of the Lower House.
