**New Delhi:** The income tax department on Saturday extended the deadline for linking the Permanent Account Number (PAN) with Aadhaar by three months, bringing much needed relief for those who have not linked the two so far.

"CBDT extends the date for linking PAN and Aadhaar from 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2019," the tax department said on Twitter. In March, the central board of direct taxes (CBDT) had extended the date for linking the two cards to September 30.

**U**nder the new rules if the PAN is not linked with Aadhaar, it would become inoperative. Tax experts said more clarity was needed on how an inoperative PAN can be re-activated again.

"The CBDT granted another three months extension to link Aadhaar with PAN. As per the recent amendment by the Finance (No. 2) Act, 2019, if a taxpayer does not link his PAN with Aadhaar number by the due date then the PAN of the taxpayer shall be deemed to be inoperative."

"A taxpayer will not be able to quote his PAN if it becomes inoperative. The department has not yet prescribed the manner in which an inoperative PAN shall be made operative again. Thus, in order to avoid any inconvenience which may be caused to the taxpayer, the board has extended the cut-off date." The government had made linking of PAN with Aadhaar mandatory since July, 2017.
